Coach Paradine also served as the defensive coordinator for Major League Lacrosse's Charlotte Hounds during the summer of 2013.

Under Paradine's defensive tutelage, the Charlotte Hounds made it all the way to the MLL Championship game in only the second year of the franchise.

Paradine, who graduated from North Carolina in December of 1993 with a bachelor's degree in geography, was a four-year letter-winner from 1990-93. He played on four Atlantic Coast Conference Championship Teams and four NCAA Tournament squads. In addition, Paradine was part of the 1991 NCAA National Championship squad, 1993 national 1992.finalists and 1990 and 1992 semifinalists.

Paradine was a first-team All-American in 1993 and an honorable mention All-American in 1992.
